Dead or Alive

living			All living things breathe, eat, grow, move, reproduce and have senses.
dead			Something that was once a living thing.
non-living			Something that has never been alive.

reproduce	to create young, offspring or babies
excrete	to get rid of unwanted substances from the body
respire	to breathe
habitat	the natural place where an living thing can survive
microhabitat	a small natural area where a living thing can survive,
survive	to remain alive
producer	a plant at the start of a food chain
consumer	a living thing that eats other living things
