

In this unit, I will:

- ☐ Make simple links between Bible texts and the concept of 'Gospel' (good news), which tells the story of the life and teaching of Jesus.
- ☐ Find links between the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus and be 'fishers of people'.
- ☐ Use stories, such as Jesus' actions towards the leper, to know that Christians try to put Jesus' teaching and example into practice in lots of ways, from church worship to social justice.
- ☐ Connect Bible stories studied and the importance of love, and life in the world today, expressing some of my own ideas clearly and reflecting respectfully on what motivates and challenges me and others to act with compassion.
