Look carefully at the words below. Say each word aloud, then trace over the dark and dotted letters, looking carefully at where each letter starts and joins. There is more handwriting help on the website.

Cover the word with a piece of card (like a strip of cereal box that you have decorated) and write it again using the handwriting lines. Remember that your descenders (like 'y' and 'g') need to hang a little under the bottom line.

Check your spelling and repeat - look, say, cover, write and check. Do not do a whole line in one day. Use your phonics to help you to spell the first three words and then remember that the last two are tricky words. Use the lines below to repeat any challenging spellings.
