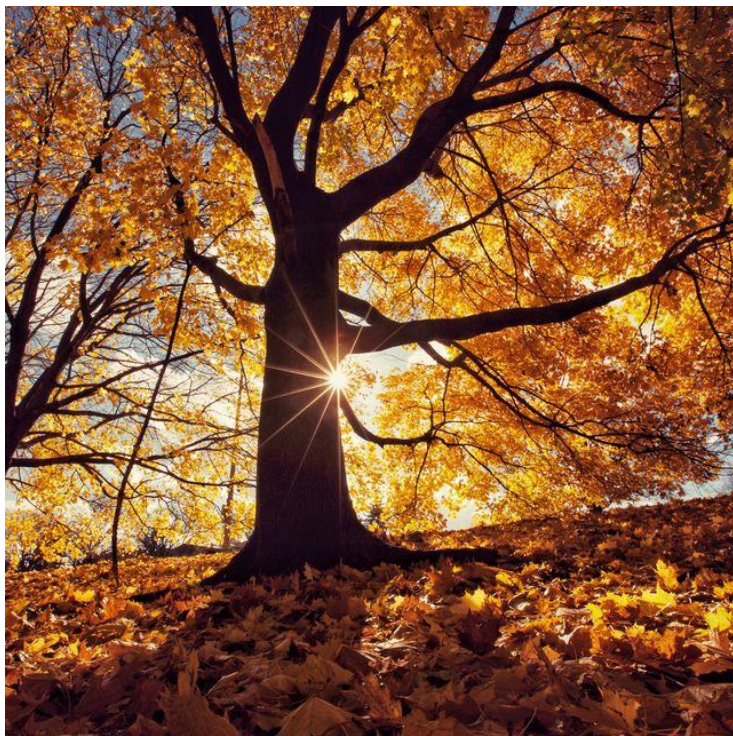


Our Learning in Nursery

WB 01.09.25

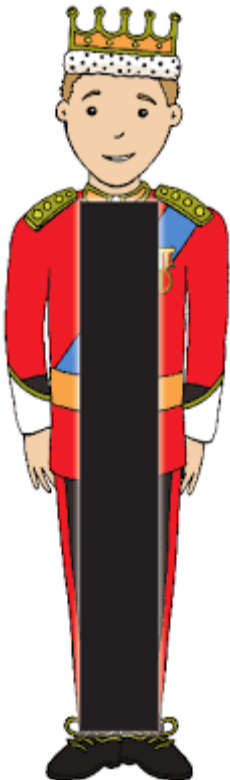
In Science we looked inside a pumpkin.



We celebrated Harvest.

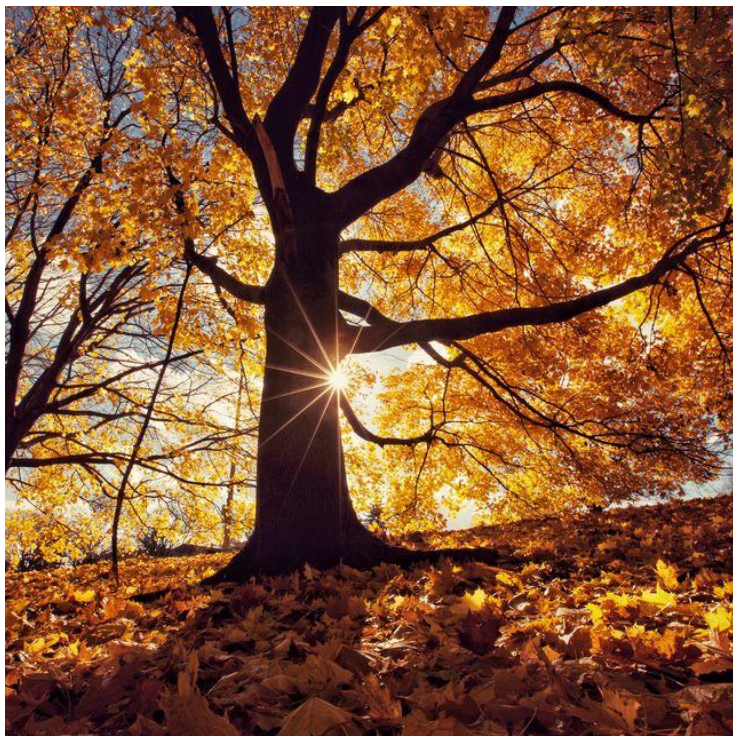


In Maths we have been exploring number one.

In Maths we have been subitising. We sorted cards into 1 and 2.

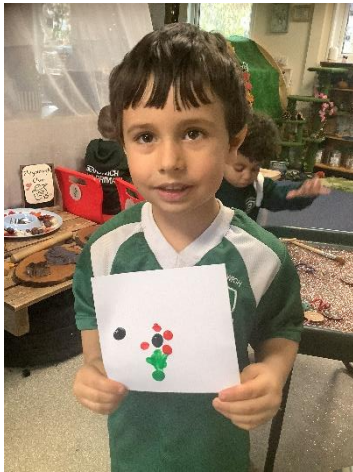


GKY dance visited us - we enjoyed learning some dance moves and becoming a lion!
