WB 05.01.26



This week we have been reading 'Here We Are'. We have been learning all about space, planets and the Earth. The children have enjoyed exploring our space provision around our classroom.



In Music we have been learning songs with actions. We learnt the Makaton sings for 'Row row your boat'

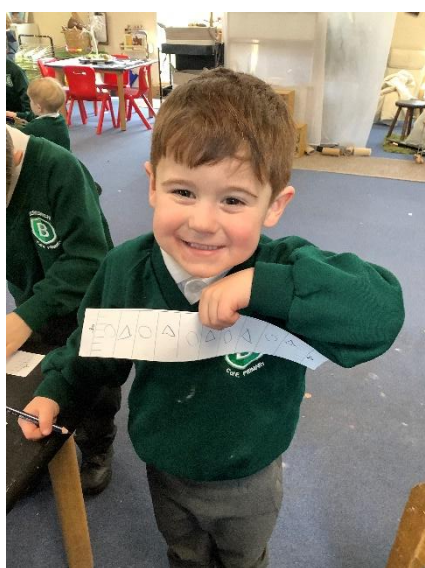
In Music we learnt about the tempo of the music. We organised the songs we heard into fast, medium and slow. And then moved in different ways to the music.

In Science we sorted Mummy animals with their babies and talked about the names of them.

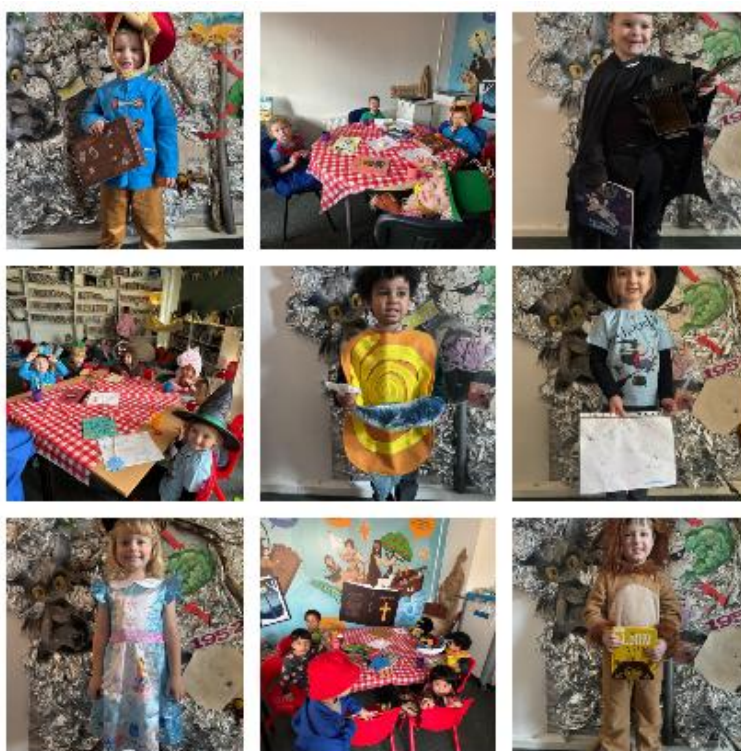

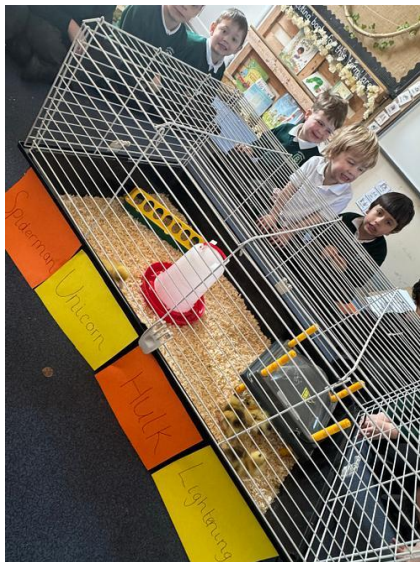
We had a great PE lesson today! We moved around the hall as cars, bikes, aeroplanes and buses. We enjoyed playing the team games too!
